Buses: 65, 74\*

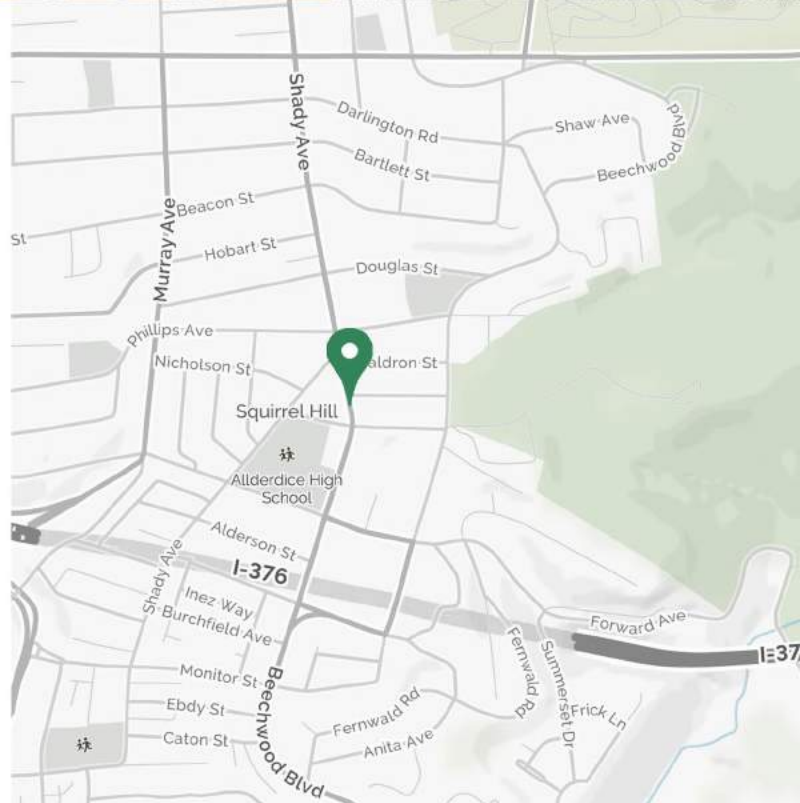
With stops at Beechwood and
