| Poverty | Percent of families living below the poverty line | 2011-2015 | ESRI Updated Demographics, ACS 5-year estimates |
| Youth | Percent of residents who are under 18 | 2017 | ESRI Updated Demographics |
| Seniors | Percent of residents who are 65 and older | 2017 | ESRI Updated Demographics |
| Vacancy | Percent of parcels that are vacant | 2018 | Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh |
| Violent Crime | Violent crime reports to the Pittsburgh Police Department per acre of walkshed land | 2017 | City of Pittsburgh Police Bureau, Department of Public Safety, WPRDC |
| Asthma | Percent of adults reporting to have asthma (estimates) | 2015 | CDC 500 Cities & PolicyMap |
| Obesity | Percent of adults reporting to be obese, with a BMI of 30 or greater (estimates) | 2015 | CDC 500 Cities & PolicyMap |
| Diabetes | Percent of adults ever diagnosed with diabetes (estimates) | 2015 | CDC 500 Cities & PolicyMap |
| Anxiety | Percent of residents with anxiety (estimates based on number of customers of three managed care organizations in Allegheny County who filed a claim for anxiety meds) | 2015 | Allegheny County Department of Health, WPRDC |

| Current Site Condition | Overall condition of the site and facilities. Four categories: Excellent, good, fair, and poor. | Present | DPW |
| Proportion of Site Need Met Since 2009 | Proportion of the dollar amount needed to bring the site up to a basic level of service to the sum of that number and the estimated total investment made in the site since 2009. | 2009-Present | DPW and other sources |
| <i>Environmental Scores</i> | | | |
| Sewershed Priority | Priority of the sewershed in which the site falls for interventions to mitigate combined sewer overflows / stormwater issues. Three categories: high priority, secondary priority, and low priority. | Present | PWSA |
| Tree Canopy | Percent of walkshed land covered by tree canopy | 2010 | University of Vermont Spatial Analysis Laboratory, PASDA |
| Black Carbon | Average levels of black carbon in the atmosphere | 2011-2014 | Carnegie Mellon Center for Atmospheric Particle Studies (CAPS) |
