Rental Spaces

HALF CLASSROOM

Up to 3 hours | \$150 per hr.
3 or more hours | \$500 total

Space accommodates approximately 30 guests seated or 50 theatre-style.

FULL CLASSROOM

Up to 3 hours | \$300 per hr.
3 or more hours | \$1,000 total

Space accommodates approximately 75 guests seated or 120 theatre-style.

OUTDOOR CLASSROOM

Up to 3 hours | \$150 per hr.
3 or more hours | \$500 total

Space accommodates up to 30 guests. Outdoor space is covered.

FULL INDOOR SPACE & OUTDOOR PATIO

Up to 8 hours | \$3,000

Space accommodates 75 guests seated and 125 standing. Includes outdoor covered patio, art gallery and Living Room space.

OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATRE

Up to 3 hours | \$225 per hr.
3 or more hours | \$750 total

Presentations or live music for up to 100 guests.

Events over 100 people will be charged a \$150 cleaning and composting fee.



- Times include set-up and clean-up.
- Rentals include an on-site Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy staff member.
- Nonprofits receive a 20% discount.
- All events have access to public restrooms.
- Classrooms 1 & 2 equipped with sound system, projection, assisted listening devices and classroom furniture.

- Classroom tables and chairs available inside for an additional fee. All other event tables and chairs must be rented.
- Public events with 25 or more people require a Special Event Permit from the City of Pittsburgh, which PPC will assist in obtaining. Persons desiring to hold rallies, protests or other First Amendment activity are directed to contact the City of Pittsburgh Special Events Office at 412-255-2641 for a permit and any requested City services.
