



Weather Policy for the Trackchair Program

The Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy (PPC) reserves the right to cancel or end any outing due to inclement weather to ensure the safety of all individuals. A PPC staff member will monitor the weather forecast on the morning of the outing. If an outing must be cancelled, PPC staff will first call and then email the contact listed on the reservation form.

The PPC may cancel or end an outing if:

- The weather forecast predicts lightning during the outing.
- Lightning occurs during an outing, in which case the user and caregiver/volunteer must immediately head back to the Frick Environmental Center (FEC) or take shelter.
- The National Weather Service (NWS) issues a wind advisory.
- The NWS issues an extreme heat advisory, or a poor air quality alert.
- The NWS issues a severe weather warning, (i.e. severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, wind advisory, flash flood).
- If there is heavy rain. The Trackchairs cannot be exposed to high volumes of water as it may cause permanent damage to its controls and batteries.
